The Secretary of the Delegation calls the names of those summoned to the Chapter.

DECREE OF LEGITIMATE CONVOCATION

PRESIDENT:

All the Chapter Fathers present here declare that this Chapter of the Delegation has been legitimately convened both in terms of the authority and as regards to the time, place and all other conditions required for the legitimacy of the convocation. Therefore, I declare the proceedings open.

A single votation is then held for the election of two scrutineers by a simple majority. Immediately after the two have been elected, they will make the following oath, with one hand on the book of the Bible:

OATH TAKING OF TWO SCRUTINEERS

I, N., elected as scrutineer of this Chapter of the Delegation of the Clerics Regular Minor, swear to faithfully read the names of the vote and never tell anyone, directly or indirectly, the names of the voters.

May the Lord assist me and help me to keep my oath.

APPOINTMENT OF SECRETARY AND DEPUTY SECRETARY OATHTAKING OF THE PRESIDENT AND ALL CHAPTER MEMBERS

I, N., swear to faithfully fulfill my office and not to report to anybody outside of the Chapter that which can bring biases, dissensions, damage to the good name of the religious and of the Order. May the Lord help me to keep my oath.

With only a relative majority vote, two examiners of proposals will be elected.

All moral and financial reports and any other documents to be discussed in the Chapter are distributed to the Chapter Fathers

The Superior and the Treasurer of the Delegation and the superiors of each house of the Delegation, each according to their areas and skills, will present written reports highlighting the following aspects: spiritual, educational, disciplinary, apostolic and financial, with the inclusion of advancing proposals for the period after. Each report will be immediately followed by integration measures and clarification. (see Appendix for all reports)

Day 2

Deliberations and Approval of Proposals

The Chapter Fathers, at the proposal of the President, Secretaries and examiners of proposals, will decide the subsequent conduct of the work of the chapter based on the findings from these reports and proposals submitted by individual Fathers deemed significant by the examiners.

The sequence of how to proceed in dealing with individual topics:

- Brief description and delimitation of the point in question;
- Open discussion with concise and relevant presentations;
- Development of one or more combined propositions;
- Vote.

Day 3

Continuation of Deliberations and Approval of Proposals COMPLETION OF WORK
